The petitioners are seeking directions to the respondents not to harass them.

She further contends that petitioner No.1 is father, petitioner No.2 is mother and petitioner No.3 is brother of Navjeet Singh. Navjeet Singh has been disinherited by petitioners No.1 and 2. Notice dated 05.06.2021 in this regard is annexed at Annexure P-1.

Issue notice to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of the court, Mr. Amandeep Singh Gill, Senior DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. He, upon instructions from ASI Paramdeep Kumar, states that the petitioners are not required in the investigation and are not being harassed.
