The petitioner is regular bail in FIR No.09 dated 08.01.2019, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 471, 120-B IPC (Section 201 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Dhand, District Kaithal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner had helped the co-accused to obtain loan by submitting fabricated documents. The petitioner himself did not derive any amount of money and no recovery has been effected from him. He is in custody for over 3 months. He is not involved in any other criminal case.

Learned State counsel contends that challan has been filed. She also states that the petitioner had also tempered with the revenue record.

Heard.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner is not involved in any other criminal case, no recovery has been effected from him, he is in custody for over 3 months, the COVID-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
