The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.109 dated 02.08.2019 registered under Section 498-A IPC at Police Station Women District Ludhiana.

Notice of motion was issued on 04.09.2021 on the premise that marriage between the petitioner and the complainant Prabhjot Kaur was solemnized on 20.04.2018. There is no specific allegation with regard to demand of dowry, except general allegations against the petitioner. Due to

temperamental differences, the FIR was registered against the petitioner. Arrest of the petitioner was stayed. Thereafter, vide order dated 31.10.2019, petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

Today, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Bipin Kumar submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer and he is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 31.10.2019 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
