Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.0116 dated 09.09.2021 registered under Sections 306, 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Sangrur, District Sangrur.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that as per the allegations in the FIR, registered at the instance of sister of the deceased namely Manjit Kaur, in which it is stated that her brother Magar Singh, was married to Manpreet Kaur and their marriage was solemnized on 23.06.2021. It is further submitted that after 01 month of their marriage, Magar Singh was harassed by all the accused persons due to which he became mentally ill. It is also argued that even on 06.09.2021, Magar Singh had made a phone call to the complainant to take his wife i.e. the petitioner back, however later on, the complainant came to know that Magar Singh was harassed and humiliated by the petitioner and her family members and facing the said humiliation, he committed suicide by consuming some poisonous substance.

Counsel for the State has argued that very fact that despite the recent marriage with the petitioner, there are serious allegations of harassment and humiliation, which has abetted Magar Singh, to commit suicide.

After hearing the counsel for the parties and looking into the serious allegations against the petitioner, I find no ground to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Dismissed.
