Both the parties have agreed for enhancement of compensation to the tune of Rs.1,75,000/- over and above the amount of compensation already awarded by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal. This amount shall also inclusive of the interest component.

Accordingly, in the light of understanding between the parties, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.1,75,000/- in the name of the appellant and respondent No.4 with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of four weeks, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on the enhanced amount of compensation with effect from the due date till final realisation of the amount.

The enhanced amount of Rs.1,75,000/- is payable to the

appellant as well as to respondent No.4 in the ratio of 50% each as ordered by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal. On receiving the cheque from the Insurance Company, the concerned officer/official of the Lok Adalat Branch shall issue proper receipt to the Insurance Company. The appellant/appellant's counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of this order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
