1. Case is being taken up for hearing through VideoConferencing due to Covid-19pandemic.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of only one prosecution witness remaining to be examined, he does not press the instant petition and the same may be permitted to be withdrawn while issuing directions to the learned trial Court to conclude the trial, as expeditiously as possible.

In view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties and without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is ***dismissed as withdrawn***, while directing the learned trial Court to examine the remaining prosecution witnesses and to conclude the trial, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
