This is second petition for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.6 to 11 and to decide the representation dated 21.09.2021; earlier one i.e. CRWP-4681-2021 was disposed of vide order dated 28.06.2021, directing the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali) to examine the representation dated 15.04.2021 and take appropriate action in accordance with law.

Learned State counsel submits that the police has registered an FIR under Sections 307, 336, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Sections 25/27 of Arms Act, against private respondents and during investigation, Section 307 IPC was

deleted and two persons were found innocent and challan qua nine other accused stands presented on 21.10.2021. It is further submitted that now the matter is subjudice before the trial Court and the petitioner can avail the remedy of taking appropriate action before the Illaqa Magistrate, for adding Section 307 IPC, if the same is made out, as per facts of the case.

In reply, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the police is not adhering to the order dated 28.06.2021.

Be whatsoever, since the directions have already been issued to the police authorities vide order dated 28.06.2021, this second petition is not maintainable.

The petitioner, if so advised, will avail her alternative remedy, in accordance with law.

Disposed of, accordingly.
