Quashing of FIR No. 87 dated 12.11.2020 registered under Sections 379 B, 34, 395 IPC at Police Station Handesra, District Mohali and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioners on the basis of compromise has been sought.

Vide order dated 23.12.2020, parties were directed to appear before learned Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned for recording their statements and trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of compromise.
