Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.223 dated 24.11.2020 registered under Section 61 (1) of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914, at Police Station Bilga, District Jalandhar Rural.

Vide order dated 23.12.2020 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner was granted *ad-interim* anticipatory bail and directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 23.12.2020 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Ravinder Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is now not required for any further investigation in this case.

However, he has been involved in one another case of the similar nature in the same Police Station.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 23.12.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

In case the petitioner violates any terms and conditions as envisaged or involves himself into some other case, including a case of a similar nature, the State will be at liberty to file an application seeking cancellation of the bail.
