Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No. 2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No. 4 and 5.

Reply by way of affidavit of Superintendent of Police, Sub Divisional Phillaur, District Jalandhar (Rural) has been filed through e-mail. Copy of the same is taken on record.

In compliance of the order dated 06.1.2021, passed by this Court, statement of petitioner No. 1-Jyoti has been recorded where she stated that she has been living with petitioner No. 2-Manminder Kumar in a live-in relationship and she does not want to take action against anyone. Similarly statements of the private respondents have also been recorded wherein they stated that they have no objection on living petitioner No. 1

with petitioner No. 2 and they will never interfere in the life of the petitioners.

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the present petition has become infructuous and the same may be disposed of as such.

Dismissed as infructuous.
