The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 745 dated 05.10.2020, under Sections 193, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 474 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Thanesar City, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of co-accused, who are alleged to have prepared a false birth certificate. He also contends that the petitioner is working as a Lab Assistant and is not involved in any other criminal case.

This Court, by the order dated 22.01.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Ravinder Kumar, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 22.01.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
