The petitioners have filed this petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the official respondents to let grant the petitioners the pension 50% of basic pay against not completing the qualifying service of 33 years in compliance of the decision of CWP No.14641 of 2009, along with certain other prayers.

At the outset, the counsel for the petitioners submits that at this stage the petitioners would be satisfied if official respondents are directed to decide the representation dated 15.09.2021 (Annexure P-12), filed by the petitioners, within some time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Rajesh Gaur, Additional Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State and has submitted that the State is not averse to expeditious disposal of grievance of the petitioners.

In view of the above, respondent-State is directed to take a conscious decision upon the representation dated 15.09.2021 (Annexure P-12), filed by the petitioners, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

It is further ordered that in case the petitioners are found entitled to the financial benefits on such conscious decision to be taken by the respondents-State, then the same shall be actually released to them within a further period of three months from the date of such decision.

The petition stands disposed of with above said direction.
