The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Petitioners in their fourth attempt seek quashing of FIR No.83 dated 05.05.2017 registered under Sections 307, 323, 324, 379, 148, 149 IPC at Police Division No.7, Jalandhar (offence under Sections 307, 379 IPC have been deleted as per General Dairy dated 22.11.2018 (Annexure P2) and thereafter added Section 326 IPC as per Dairy dated 22.11.2018) on the basis of compromise as well as all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

Perusal of the record would show that earlier the

petitioners also filed CRM-M No.1228 of 2018 for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise dated 08.01.2018. The said petition was dismissed vide detailed order dated 25.01.2018. Thereafter, CRM-M No.54319 of 2018 was got dismissed as withdrawn on 07.12.2018 and CRM-M No.6336 of 2019 was dismissed for non-prosecution on 10.07.2019.

Now the petitioners seek quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise in their fourth attempt.

Learned State counsel on the basis of advance notice informs the Court that except four petitioners, others are still at large. Petitioner No.1 has already been declared as proclaimed offender in the year 2018 and others are also in the process of being declared as proclaimed offenders. Even qua the petitioners who are on bail, the earlier petition for quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise stands dismissed on 25.01.2018.

In view of aforesaid, no indulgence can be granted in favour of the petitioners. The present petition is accordingly dismissed.
