Instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of Cr. PC for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.239 dated 02.11.2019 for the offences under Sections 22 and 29 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station City South District Moga (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case in hand without there being any proper compliance of mandatory provisions of NDPS Act. He further submits that in fact it was not a case of secret information as has been made out by the prosecution. Hence, a prayer has been made to extend the concession of bail to the petitioner.

Per contra, learned State counsel while opposing the prayer and submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner on instructions from ASI Baldeer Singh submits that recovery of 1000 tablets of Clovidol SR-100 (commercial quantity) was effected from the petitioner in pursuance to the

secret information received by the investigating agency. The petitioner was apprehended at the spot with the alleged recovery. He has further apprised the Court that the petitioner is involved in another case under the NDPS Act.

Heard.

Prima facie, there are serious allegations against the petitioner for which he does not deserve the concession of bail. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
