The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to grant/release him all the retiral/pensionary service benefits and dues (including gratuity, dearness allowance, GPF/PF deposited by him, leave encashment, medical allowance etc. and arrears of increment and other arrears) along with interest @ 18% p.a.; as well as to decide the representation dated 08.11.2021 (Annexure P-3).

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

Mr. Pawan Sharda, Sr. Dy. Advocate General, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to him.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the parties and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the respondents to consider the representation dated 08.11.2021 (Annexure P3) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
