By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of 'pre-arrest bail', upon FIR No. 12 having been registered at Police Station NRI Moga, District Moga, on 25.12.2019, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 420/465/467/468/471/448/120-B of the IPC.

Pursuant to the order dated 30.11.2021, an affidavit of the Deputy Superintendent of Police (NRI), Moga, dated 10.12.2021, has been filed in court today, which is ordered to be taken on record.

Along with the said affidavit, the report of the Forensic Science Laboratory, Punjab, dated 05.10.2020, has been annexed.

It is stated in the affidavit that as per the FSL report, the signatures of the late Shavinder Kaur, on the “alleged rent receipts” were found to be forged, with the matter however still under investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, in view of the above, does not press this petition with it therefore dismissed as having been withdrawn.

However, no observation made by this court either in this order or any previous order, would be taken into consideration to determine the actual guilt or innocence of the petitioner, all such observations having been made only in the context of a petition filed under the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr.P.C.; and naturally, his guilt/innocence would be determined on the basis of evidence gathered/led.
