Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 447 dated 25.12.2019 under Sections 452, 336, 427, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, and all other consequential proceedings arising out of the said FIR, as the matter stands amicably settled on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 23.12.2020, the parties were directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate on 18.01.2021 for getting their statements recorded with regard to the compromise.

A report dated 19.01.2021 of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran, has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Tarn Taran and got recorded their statements regarding compromise. Learned Magistrate has stated that he is of the considered view that the compromise between the parties is valid, genuine, voluntary and without any coercion or undue influence.

In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. FIR No. 447 dated 25.12.2019 under Sections 452, 336, 427, 148 and 149 IPC and Sections 25 and 27 of Arms Act, 1959 registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
