The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 48, dated 23.10.2020, lodged under Sections 406, 498-A of IPC, registered at Police Station Women, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar (Annexure P-1).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 23rd December, 2020, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. Learned State counsel has also submitted that the parties i.e. the petitioner and the complainant-wife have subsequent to the registration of the FIR in question,

arrived at an amicable settlement.

Learned State counsel on instructions from SI Gurmeet Singh, has has further submitted that the petitioner is no longer required for further investigation, much less, custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 23rd December, 2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
