The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

Quashing of FIR No. 461 dated 16.7.2016 registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120 B IPC at Police Station Faridabad Central, District Faridabad and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioner on the basis of compromise has been sought.

Vide order dated 23.12.2020, parties were directed to appear before Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned for recording their statements and trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of compromise.

Report of learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridabad received wherein it is stated that compromise so effected is for amicable settlement of the dispute and was effected without any external pressure, coercion or force and is a valid compromise.

In view thereof, this petition is allowed. FIR No. 461 dated 16.7.2016 registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120 B IPC at Police Station Faridabad Central, District Faridabad and all other subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua petitioner are hereby quashed.
