The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.48 dated 19.05.2018 registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 467, 471 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Cantt Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

As per allegations one Manmohan Nath brother of the complainant went missing in the year 1998. He had executed a General Power of Attorney in favour of Jaswant Singh and in pursuance of said General Power of Attorney, a sale deed was executed in favour of co-accused Vijay Kumar by showing Manmohan Nath to be alive.

Notice of motion was issued on the basis of grant of anticipatory bail. Co-accused Vijay Kumar who is identically placed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in compliance of the order dated 23.12.2020, the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Harbans Singh has admitted the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation firstly on 05.04.2021 and secondly on 04.07.2021 and he is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 23.12.2020 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
