The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the retirement dues of the petitioner which are due since the retirement of the petitioner i.e. 30.04.2021 along with interest @ 18% per annum with a further direction to the respondents to fix/release the Pension of the petitioner from the date of retirement of the petitioner along with the arrears of the pension with immediate effect along with interest @ 18% per annum keeping in view of the facts and circumstances of the present case.

Upon hearing learned counsel of both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 17.08.2021 (Annexure P-2) as representation moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for grant of relief, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
