The matter has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of COVID-19.

Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 335 dated 15.10.2020 registered under Section 15 of the NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Murthal, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is not the owner of the *dhaba* and his name surfaces on the basis of the disclosure statement made by the co-accused Nitin. No recovery was effected from the petitioner.

As per the status report by way of affidavit of Nikita Khatta, Assistant Superintendent of Police, Sonipat, the petitioner is involved in two other cases under the NDPS Act.

Noticing the fact that the petitioner is involved in the other cases as well, no case is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
