This case has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition was filed seeking a mandamus for directing the Ist respondent i.e. the State Registrar of Societies, Haryana, to take a decision on the appeal dated 24.01.2020 at Annexure P-5 that had been filed by the petitioner assailing the order dated 21.01.2020 (Annexure P-4) passed by the District Registrar, Firms & Societies, Hisar.

It is the contention raised by counsel that the appeal at Annexure P-5 is towards exhausting a statutory remedy and under such circumstances respondent No.1 ought to consider the same on merits and take a final decision thereupon.

An advance copy of the petition had already been served upon State of Haryana.

Mr. Sharan Sethi, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana upon instructions from respondent No.1 himself, makes a statement that the appeal dated 24.01.2020 (Annexure P-5) would be decided within a period of four weeks from today.

Statement is accepted.

In view of the above no further directions are required to be passed.

Writ petition is disposed of as infructuous.

It is clarified that this Court has not examined the case on merits.
