The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.176 dated 27.07.2019 under Sections 406/498-A IPC 1860 (Sections 493/120-B IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Beas District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that pursuant to order dated 06.03.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation. This fact is not disputed by the counsel for the State as well.

Affidavit filed by Assistant Sub Inspector on behalf of respondent No.1 is taken on record. As per the affidavit, recovery of certain articles has not yet been effected.

However, learned counsel for the petitioners has disputed the same by alleging that whatever was in their possession stands returned.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Charan Singh states that the petitioners are no longer required for further interrogation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 06.03.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
