ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.08 dated 26.07.2020, under Sections 21, 22, 25, 27-A, 29 of the NDPS Act and Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station State Special Operation Cell, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that neither the petitioner is named in the FIR nor any recovery has been effected from him. He has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of the co-accused from whom the recovery of contraband and arms were effected. The petitioner is 30 years of age and is in custody for about 06 months.

Learned State counsel upon instructions from Sub Inspector Gagandeep Singh states that challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioner, who is 30 years old, is in custody for about 06 months, no recovery has been effected from him, Covid 19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
