Main case

The petitioner is seeking his release on interim bail for a period of three months as his mother is stated to be unwell.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is an accused in FIR No.338 dated 25.07.2019, under Sections 302, 201, 34 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Ganaur, District Sonapat. The petitioner is in custody for over two years since his arrest on 20.08.2019 and is not involved in any other criminal case. The mother of the petitioner is suffering from various ailments including thyroid, high blood sugar and was to be operated for gall bladder stone. There is no male member in the family to look after the ailing mother of the petitioner. He also contends that the petitioner may be granted interim bail on heavy surety.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from PSI Amit Kumar, states that the mother of the petitioner was operated upon for gall bladder stone on 25.11.2021 and has been discharged on 29.11.2021 from Government Medical College for Women, Khanpur Kalan, Sonapat.

Heard.

The petitioner is in custody for over two years. He is not involved in any other criminal case. The mother of the petitioner is unwell. In these circumstances, it would be in the interest of justice if the petitioner is granted interim bail for a period of one week to visit his ailing mother.

Consequently, the petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on interim bail for a period of one week, i.e. from 02.12.2021 to 09.12.2021, subject to his furnishing adequate bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Duty Magistrate. The petitioner shall surrender before the jail authorities concerned on 09.12.2021 by 05:00 p.m.

At the time of release of the petitioner, the SHO of the concerned Police Station shall be informed and the petitioner shall furnish his mobile number to him. The petitioner shall also keep the location of his phone on till he reports back to the concerned jail.
