The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 58 dated 09.06.2018, under Sections 420, 406 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Sujampur, District Pathankot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had earlier been granted anticipatory bail by this Court and later was found innocent in the course of investigation. He has now been summoned upon an application under Section 319 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973.

This Court, by the order dated 18.11.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the trial Court and on his doing so, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in terms of order dated 18.11.2021, the petitioner had appeared before the trial Court on

23.11.2021 and has been granted interim bail.

Learned counsel for the complainant, however, contends that in view of the serious allegations against the petitioner, he is not entitled to the concession of anticipatory bail.

In view of the above, the order dated 18.11.2021 granting interim bail to petitioner is made absolute.

The petition stands disposed of.

However, the petitioner shall henceforth appear before the Court on each and every date of hearing and would not absent himself except with prior permission of the Court.
