This is the second petition that has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the FIR No. 746 dated 25.09.2020 under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 469, 471, 506, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Panipat City, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner while inter-alia contending that the petitioner being an illiterate lady has been falsely implicated in the present case.
