A divorce petition has been filed by the respondent. Defence of the petitioner has been struck off by the impugned order as written statement was not filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the written statement could not be filed as a transfer petition has been filed and the same is pending. Further, only two adjournments were taken for filing the written statement and thus, the order is too harsh.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, issuance of notice of motion is dispensed with.

The revision petition is allowed and the impugned order is set aside. The petitioner is granted one last and final opportunity for filing the written statement. Written statement be filed on the next date of hearing. No further opportunity shall be granted.
