The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

This is a petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of order dated 31.7.2018 (Annexure P-2) passed by learned JMIC, Moga in complaint case No. NACT 449-2016 dated 12.10.2016 under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881, whereby petitioner has been declared a proclaimed person, on the basis of compromise (Annexure P-2).

Learned counsel for petitioner states that since wrong address of petitioner was mentioned in complaint, therefore, proper service was not effected. He states that he never had intention to evade proceedings of the Court.

In view thereof, petitioner may appear before trial Court on or before 16.2.2021. On his doing so, he will be released on bail to satisfaction of trial Court. This shall be however be subject to deposit of Rs. 25000/- in Director, PGI Chandigarh Poor Patient Welfare Fund.

Petition is disposed of.
