LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

The appellants have filed this appeal seeking enhancement of compensation awarded to them vide award dated 02.07.2015, passed by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Gurgaon.

During the pendency of this appeal the matter, it is submitted has been amicably settled between the appellants and respondent-Insurance Company.

It has been decided that a sum of Rs.1,50,000/- over and above, the awarded amount i.e., Rs.7,53,000/-, shall be paid to the claimants. Photocopy of the cheque in favour of appellant no.1 is attached as Annexure A-2. Appellants no.2 and 3 i.e., sons of appellant no.1, have specifically agreed to issuance of the cheque in favour of their mother i.e., appellant no.1. Learned counsel for the appellant-claimant affirms and verifies the factum of settlement between the

parties. Affidavit of appellant no.1 and a joint affidavit of appellants no.2 and 3, has been circulated on the whatsapp group created for the purpose of video conferencing today. Print out of the same be taken and attached with the file.

Learned counsel for the appellants-claimants submits that the said affidavits shall be filed with the Registry of this Court within one week.

Mr. Rajbir Singh, Advocate, learned counsel for respondent no.3- Insurance Company, submits that the cheque in question, shall be handed over to appellant no.1 within one week.

Learned counsel for the appellants-claimants reaffirms and verifies settlement between the parties and submits that the appellant-claimants have no objection, in case, the main appeal is disposed of in view of the settlement as above.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above FAO No. 6934 of 2015 is disposed of in terms of the settlement arrived at between the appellant-claimants and respondent-Insurance Company. It is directed that the cheque in question be handed over to the appellant-claimant no.1 within one week from today and affidavits of the appellants circulated on the whatsapp group created for video conferencing, be filed with the Registry of this Court within one week. Needless to say, in case, the said amount is not released to the appellants, they are at liberty to move an appropriate application in this appeal. Pending application/s, if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
