The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR
No.167 dated 06.12.2020, registered under Sections 307, 506 and 34
IPC at Police Station City Rampura, District Bathinda.

The operative part of the order dated 07.01.2021, vide
which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioner, is
reproduced as under:-

*“...Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon
order dated 17.12.2020 passed in CRM-M-42542-2020,
vide which co-accused Jatinder Singh Bhalla and one
more co-accused have been granted the concession of
interim anticipatory bail as they volunteered to hand over
Rs.25,000/- each for giving it to the victim towards
medical expenses without prejudice to their right.*

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits

that as per the allegations in the FIR, the petitioner is alleged to have given a baseball bat blow on the head of the victim and he is also ready to pay an amount of Rs.50,000/- to the victim as compensation towards medical expenses.

Counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 07.01.2021, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation. It is further submitted that petitioner has handed over a cheque of Rs.50,000/-. A copy of the same is taken on record.

Counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Rajwinder Singh, assisted by counsel for the complainant, has not disputed the aforesaid fact, however, submits that the petitioners are still required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 07.01.2021 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it will be open for the Investigating Officer to issue a notice in writing if the petitioners are still required for any further investigation.
