Petitioner Neha Sharma, who had taken up examination for appointment to solitary post of Public Communication Officer with Gurugram Metropolitan Development Authority, Gurugram and is said to have cleared the said examination being No.1 in the merit list, having secured 66 marks, is aggrieved by the fact that she has not been given appointment so far and rather some officer already working has been given current duty charge of that post. According to her, she has submitted representations dated 25.08.2021 and 22.09.2021 (Annexures P-5 and P-6 respectively) to respondent No.2 but that did not evoke any response. As such, she has filed the present writ petition.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider the representations and then take appropriate action in the matter.

Under the circumstances, in order to enable the respondents

to consider the claim of the petitioner and to avoid unnecessary litigation, the present writ petition is disposed of directing respondent No.2-Deputy Secretary, Gurugram Metropolitan Development Authority, Gurugram to consider the representations dated 25.08.2021 and 22.09.2021 (Annexures P-5 and P-6 respectively) of the petitioner as per law, rules, regulations and instructions on the subject and if some action in the matter is warranted, then the needful be done in accordance with law, within a period of 02 months from the date of receipt of copy of this order, by way of passing a speaking order, copy of which be sent to the petitioner as per registered AD post.
