The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 241 dated 30.11.2020, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 326 and 506 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Babain, District Kurukshetra.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although the petitioner is named in the FIR, but no specific injury is attributed to her. She was unarmed and is alleged to have joined other accused in punching and kicking the complainant. He also contends that the petitioner is a lady with minor children and is not involved in any other case.

This Court, by the order dated 23.12.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of her arrest, she was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Jasbir Singh, contends that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 23.12.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. She shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
