The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking a direction to the official respondents to take appropriate legal action against respondent No.4 for committing fraud and cheating by usurping the share of the property of the petitioner by preparing forged and fabricated documents.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer to the extent that his representation/complaint dated 23.7.2021 (Annexure P-2) should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3 only.

At this stage, on the asking of the court, Mr. A.S. Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab, who is present through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents and submits that respondents will look into the matter and will decide the representation of the petitioner. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be

supplied to him during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the respondents to decide the representation/complaint dated 23.7.2021 (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
