TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA. J. (ORAL)

This order shall dispose of CWP No.119-2021 titled as “Satpal Singh versus State of Haryana and others and CWP No. 68-2021 titled as “Man Singh versus State of Haryana and others.

Petitioners are essentially aggrieved of the action of the respondents- Haryana Shehari Vikas Pradikaran in having rejected their claim for allotment of plot(s) under the oustee's category. We may notice

that in CWP No. 119-2021 the order of rejection does not assign any reason. In so far as the CWP 68-2021 is concerned the claim for allotment of plot has been rejected on the basis that the land acquired was only 10%.

Case projected on behalf of the petitioner (Man Singh) is that such finding is perverse in as much the entire land holding i.e. 100% had been acquired.

Mr. Rajesh K. Sheoran, learned counsel representing the respondent- Haryana Shehari Vikas Pradikaran makes a statement that after filing of the writ petitions, a subsequent development has taken place inasmuch a decision has been taken that cases of both the petitioners herein would be reconsidered as per law.

It is further submitted that by virtue of the exercise of reconsideration which would be now undertaken, the impugned orders of rejection in both the writ petitions would cease to operate.

Mr. Rajesh K. Sheoran, learned counsel further submits that it would now be open for the petitioner(s) in these two writ petitions to apply afresh for allotment of a plot under the oustee's category within a period of 15 days on the web portal of the Haryana Shehari Vikas Pradikaran from today.

In the eventuality of the petitioners doing so their claim for allotment under the oustee's category would be considered and dealt with as per terms and conditions of the applicable policy governing allotment under the oustee's category and by passing a speaking order within a period of three months from the date of submission of application(s) by the

petitioners.

Statement made by Mr. Rajesh K. Sheoran, learned counsel for
Haryana Shehari Vikas Pradikaran is accepted.

No further directions are required to be passed.

Writ petitions are disposed of.
