Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that there is no threat perception. He further prays for withdrawal of the present petition with liberty to file a fresh petition in case threat perception arises in future.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Raj Singh, does not dispute the contention made by counsel for the petitioners.

On the other hand, learned counsel appearing for the private respondents has argued that first petitioner is in Canada since 2019 and as such, this petition should not be entertained by this Court.

Given above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioners to approach this Court and file a fresh petition in case any threat perception arises in future.

The interim protection order dated 17.11.2021, is hereby recalled.
