1. By these writ petitions, petitioners have challenged the order dated 11.11.2020 (Annexure P-7) passed by respondent No.2 and order dated 13.10.2016 (Annexure P-3) passed by respondent No.3 in the proceedings under Sections 7 of the Punjab Village Common Land Act (Regulation) 1961 (for short 'the Act') for evicting them from the land in dispute.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On advance notice, Mr.Vivek Saini, Addl.A.G.Haryana and

Mr.Vishwajeet, Advocate, accept notice on behalf of respondents-State and respondent No.4-Gram Panchayat village Tito Kheri, Tehsil Safidon, District Jind (Haryana) respectively.

4. During the hearing, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioners have moved an application to the Gram Panchayat for purchase of the land.

5. Learned counsel for respondent No.4 submits that the said application has already been recommended to BDPO and that would normally be the end of the matter.

6. Learned State counsel submits that to his knowledge, the BDPO has rejected the application vide order dated 15.02.2021.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he would obtain a copy of the order and file a fresh writ petition if so advised, by withdrawing the present writ petitions.

8. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

9. Since the main case has been decided, the pending civil miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
