1. Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.
2. Permission granted.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn.
4. However, if the investigating officer concerned, has prepared the closure report, therefore, if he deems fit, to file it before the learned Judicial Magistrate concerned, he may forthwith do so. Subsequently, the learned Judicial Magistrate, after hearing the objections of the objector concerned, shall make thereons a decision, in accordance with law.
5. If the petitioner is aggrieved from the learned Magistrate declining to accept the closure report, he may proceed, to take recourse to an appropriate remedy, in accordance with law.
