As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant,
learned counsel and representative of the respondent-Insurance Company
(separately recorded), a sum of Rs.6,00,000/- (Six lakhs Only) over & above the
amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full & final
settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for
the appellant, the enhanced amount be paid to the appellant- Veena Negi.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance
Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs.6,00,000/- in the name of the appellant
with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 15.09.2021, in
compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on
this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the
Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to
learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company.

The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok

Adalat.

Copy of order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
