1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for the issuance of a writ, order or direction in the nature of Habeas Corpus for release of the detenue from the illegal and unlawful custody of respondent Nos.3 to 8 from House No.2302, Sector 44, Chandigarh by appointing a Warrant Officer.

3. Mr. C.S. Bakshi, Advocate, puts in appearance on behalf of respondent Nos.1 & 2, while Mr. C.M. Munjal, Advocate, puts in appearance on behalf of respondent Nos.3 to 8.

4. Learned counsel for the respondents state that pursuant to the orders of this Court dated 23.12.2020, the alleged detenue, namely

Shivani Gandhi @ Divya (daughter of the petitioner) was recovered

from the custody of respondent Nos.3 to 8 from House No.2302, Sector 44, Chandigarh by the Warrant Officer and was handed over to the petitioner by recording her statement that she would like to go along with the petitioner, i.e. her father and that in the circumstances, no further orders are called for in the instant petition.

5. In view of the position as noted above, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the criminal writ petition and the same may be disposed of, as not calling for any further orders.

6. In view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the criminal writ petition is ***disposed of***, as not calling for any further orders.
