SUDHIR MITTAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner retired from the post of Junior Engineer on 27th July 2018. His grievance however is that employer's share of CPF, Gratuity, leave encashment and GIS dues have not been released till date. Even legal notice dated 30th September 2020 (Annexure P-9) has not yielded any result.

Considering the nature of the order being passed, there is no necessity of issuing notice of motion to the respondents.

In the first instance, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to Chief Administrator, Punjab Urban Planning and Development Authority to decide the legal notice dated 30th September 2020 (Annexure P-9) expeditiously in accordance with law and rules by passing a speaking order not later than six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case it is found that complete retiral benefits have not been released, the arrears be paid to the petitioner within two weeks thereafter along with interest @ 9% per annum.
