The present petition has been filed seeking protection to the life and liberty of the petitioner as well as his family members with a further prayer that the petitioner be allowed to meet his sister namely Afsana @ Tulsi, who is stated to be married to respondent No.4, so as to know the well being of his sister.

Learned counsel for the petitioner very fairly submits that the petitioner is ready to file a representation with the respondents raising the said apprehension and, therefore, respondent No.3. i.e. SHO, Police Station Maloya, Chandigarh may kindly be directed to decide the said representation of the petitioner expeditiously so that well being of his sister is ensured.

Learned State counsel submits that in case any representation is filed by the petitioner raising any apprehension with regard to the well being of his sister, who is stated to be married to respondent No.4, the same will be decided within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of the said representation after following due process of law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement made by the learned State counsel, the petitioner does not press the present writ petition any further and the same may be disposed of as such with liberty as prayed for.
