The petitioner herein seeks the relief of regular bail in the criminal case arising out of the FIR bearing No.185 dated 01.08.2021 registered at Police Station City Phagwara, District Kapurthala, under Sections 307, 326, 324, 341, 506, 148 and 149 IPC as well as Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, with the allegations that he, along-with his co-accused, caused injuries to Balvir Singh and Balwinder Singh with the weapons like pistol, Gandasi, Kirpan etc.

Mr. Sukhbeer Singh, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, has joined the proceedings in this case in pursuance of the notice of the instant petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance. Custody certificate of the petitioner has also been submitted in the Court and the same is taken on the record.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner as well as learned State counsel in the present petition and have also perused the file

thoroughly.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is behind the bars since the date of his arrest, i.e 01.08.2021 and is also not involved in any other case of the similar nature and the Challan has already been presented in the Court and even otherwise, no specific injury to any of the injured persons has been attributed to him and moreover, his co-accused named Vijay Kumar has already been extended the relief of regular bail by this Court vide the order dated 09.11.2021 and in these circumstances, the petitioner deserves the relief as sought in this petition.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the above-referred factual position.

Keeping in view the afore-discussed facts and circumstances as well as the fact that the trial of the case is likely to take sufficient time to conclude and without commenting or expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the petitioner named Daman @ Dali is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to his furnishing the requisite personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The instant petition stands allowed accordingly.
