HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J. (ORAL)

The petitioners are seeking a direction from this Court to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect their life and liberty as they apprehend danger to their life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 and 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case where there was a litigation pending between the parties and there was apprehension in the minds of the petitioners with regard to the threat to their life and liberty, the said apprehension was brought to the notice of respondent No.2 along with certain other issues vide representation dated 25.08.2021 (Annexure P-8).

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is given to respondent No.2 to decide the same by passing appropriate speaking order.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Pawan Singh,

submits that that after the receipt of representation dated 25.08.2021 (Annexure P-8), notices were issued to the petitioners for 16.09.2021 to come so as to ascertain the facts mentioned therein, but no one had turned up including the petitioners and, thereafter, the said representation was consigned to records by the authorities.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he does not have instructions qua the said development. He submits that as the the grievance of the petitioners still subsists, they be given liberty to approach the concerned Police Authorities once again raising the said grievance.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Pawan Singh, submits that in case any grievance is raised by the petitioners before any Authority, the same will be considered and appropriate order will be passed within a period of two months from the date of receipt of any representation from the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned State counsel, no further grievance of the petitioners survives in the present petition at this stage and the same may be disposed of having been not pressed any further.

The writ petition stands disposed of.

It will be appreciated that before passing the order on the representation, if any, submitted by the petitioners, the persons, who are likely to be effected, be also heard.
