The matter has been taken up through video conferencing in the light of COVID-19 pandemic.

Present petition has been filed by the petitioner for issuance of direction to respondents No.2 and 3 for taking necessary and appropriate action against respondents No.6 to 9 and their associates.

The grievance of the petitioner is that respondents No.6 to 9 and other associates have forged the agreement to sell of the house of petitioner in order to usurp the same and for harassing and intimidating the petitioner and her family members in order to forcibly dispossess them from the residential house. Respondents No.6 to 9 are doing so, in connivance with respondent No.5, ASI Meet Ram. It is also the grievance of the petitioner that even though, complaint has been filed by the petitioner before the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana and various other authorities on 03.09.2020, copy whereof is Annexure P-2, but no action has been initiated by the official respondents upon the same.

Notice of motion.

Mr. M.S. Nagra, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of official respondents and gives assurance about initiation of action upon the complaint dated 03.09.2020, copy whereof is Annexure P-2.

In view of the submission so made and assurance so give by learned State Counsel the present petition is hereby disposed of with the direction to respondents No.3 and 4 to consider the grievance of the petitioner in view of the complaint dated 03.09.2020, copy whereof is Annexure P-2, and to initiate action upon the same in accordance with law, if so required and dispose of the same within a period of eight weeks from today onwards.

Accordingly, the petition stands disposed of.

However, these observations are circumscribed only for the purposes of disposal of the present petition, without prejudice to the rights of the parties, to be adjudicated in any civil or criminal proceedings.
