The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in respect of FIR No. 373 dated 25.09.2021, registered under Sections 420, 406 IPC at Police Station Israna, District Panipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that petitioner has nothing to do with the allegations with regard to the fake marriage, which co-accused Pooja performed with the complainant. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there are no other cases pending against the petitioner so as to show that she was operating in-conivance with the co-accused to defraud innocent people under the pretext of marriage.

Mr. Gaurav Bansal, learned Assistant Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned State counsel submits that petitioner is not only involved in the present case but is also involved in FIR No. 224 dated 13.09.2021, registered under Sections 420, 379, 384 and 506 read with Section 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar, Patiala on the same allegations.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner does not wish to press this petition any further and the same may be disposed of as such.
