The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking a direction to respondent No. 2 to make a detailed inquiry into the complaints made by the petitioner against respondents No. 3 to 6 who in connivance with each others have forced Rohit Kumar son of the petitioner to commit suicide and forcibly and illegally occupied her property.

At this stage, counsel for the petitioner limits his prayer to the extent that his representation dated 15.10.2021 (Annexure P-8) should be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 and 2 only.

At this stage, on the asking of the court, Mr. A.S. Gill, Sr. DAG, Punjab, who is present through the medium of video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondent and submits that respondent will look into the matter and will decide the representation of the

petitioner. Let sufficient number of copies of the paper book be supplied to him during the course of the day, failing which no action is called for.

In view of the above, I dispose of the instant petition by directing the respondents to decide the representation dated 15.10.2021 (Annexure P-8) of the petitioner within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.

The petition stands disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
