The matter is taken up for hearing through video conference due to COVID-19 situation.

This is a petition seeking regular bail in FIR No. 386 dated 9.11.2020 under Section 15 of NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Sadar, Dabwali, District Sirsa.

Brief facts are that on 9.11.2020 during routine patrolling a woman was seen sitting on footpath holding a plastic sack. On seeing the police vehicle she started walking, the plastic sack fell and some poppy husk came out of it. She was apprehended and 12 kilo 500 grams *Chura Post* was recovered.

Mr. N.K. Ganga, Advocate appearing for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is 72 years of age; has been falsely implicated; she is in custody since 9.11.2020; no recovery is to be made; challan has been presented and investigation is complete.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Shailender Kumar submits that recovery is of 12.5 kgs of *Chura Post* and opposes the grant of bail.

Considering that the recovery is of non-commercial quantity; investigation is complete and conclusion of trial is likely to take time, the petitioner is directed to be released on bail subject to her furnishing of surety bonds to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate concerned.

The petition is disposed of.
