The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

It is not in dispute that the petitioner claimed the relief sought in the present writ petition before the Arbitrator appointed under Section 3G (5) of the National Highway Act, 1956, which was not acceded to. The petitioner has already filed objections under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, before the Court while objecting to the correctness of the award passed by the Arbitrator.
